

## Scripture References Used For Preparing the message "The Seriousness of Sin"

Note these are not in order as used in the sermon, but are the actual sermon study and preparation notes used.

God never made light of sin..In fact He has very graphic descriptions of it

Acts 13:38 *Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins*

I Cor 6:18 *Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body.*

Proverbs 14:9 *Fools make a mock at sin: but among the righteous there is favour.*

Romans 3:23 *For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God*

James 1:15 *Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death*

1 John 5:17 *All unrighteousness is sin: and there is a sin not unto death.*

1 John 1:8 *If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.*

Gen 18:20 *And the LORD said, Because the cry of Sodom and Gomorrah is great, and because their sin is very grievous;*

Ish 59:2 *But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear.*

Evil in his site: Psalm 51:4 *Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest.*

Against heaven: Luke 15:21 *And the son said unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and in thy sight, and am no more worthy to be called thy son.*

Sin is of Devil: 1 John 3:8 *He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.*

Holds one captive Prv 5:22 *His own iniquities shall take the wicked himself, and he shall be holden with the cords of his sins*

- Psalm 19:13 *Keep back thy servant also from presumptuous sins; let them not have dominion over me: then shall I be upright, and I shall be innocent from the great transgression.*

- John 8:34 *Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin.*

Sin Causes us to be trapped, sink:

Psalm 69:14 *Deliver me out of the mire, and let me not sink: let me be delivered from them that hate me, and out of the deep waters.*

Makes one sick/takes away rest/brings death destruction misery

Ps 6:2 -3 *Have mercy upon me, O LORD; for I am weak: O LORD, heal me; for my bones are vexed. My soul is also sore vexed*

Micah 6:13 *Therefore also will I make thee sick in smiting thee, in making thee desolate because of thy sins.* says sickness and desolation are the result

Psalms 41:4 *I said, LORD, be merciful unto me: heal my soul; for I have sinned against thee.*

Overthrows us

Proverbs 13:6 *Righteousness keepeth him that is upright in the way: but wickedness overthroweth the sinner.*

Sin is Foolish: Psalm 69:5 *O God, thou knowest my foolishness; and my sins are not hid from thee.*

- Proverbs 24:9 *The thought of foolishness is sin:*

Sin Hardens heart: Exodus 9:34 *And when Pharaoh saw that the rain and the hail and the thunders were ceased, he sinned yet more, and hardened his heart, he and his servants.*

Sin causes and brings guilt

Numbers 5:6 *Speak unto the children of Israel, When a man or woman shall commit any sin that men commit, to do a trespass against the LORD, and that person be guilty;*

Sin testifies against us

Isaiah 59:12 *For our transgressions are multiplied before thee, and our sins testify against us: for our transgressions are with us; and as for our iniquities, we know them;*

Sin can cause us to quickly turn: Deuteronomy 9:16 *And I looked, and, behold, ye had sinned against the LORD your God, and had made you a molten calf: ye had turned aside quickly out of the way which the LORD had commanded you.*

Provokes God to jealousy/anger: 1 Kings 14:22/16:2 *And Judah did evil in the sight of the LORD, and they provoked him to jealousy with their sins which they had committed, above all that their fathers had done.*

Our sin causes others to sin 21:22

Wrongs our Soul: Proverbs 8:36 *But he that sinneth against me wrongeth his own soul: all they that hate me love death*

Makes us ashamed: Mark 8:38 *Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he cometh in the glory of his Father with the holy angels.*

Sin Destroys us: Ecclesiastes 9:18 *Wisdom is better than weapons of war: but one sinner destroyeth much good.*

Sin brings Death: 2 Chronicles 25:4 *But he slew not their children, but did as it is written in the law in the book of Moses, where the LORD commanded, saying, The fathers shall not die for the children, neither shall the children die for the fathers, but every man shall die for his own sin.*

Can die in sins: (Jesus) John 8:24 *I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins.*

Death the paycheck for sin: Rom 6:23 *For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.*

Det 6 commands to obey God and Gal 5 list of sins

Romans 6:12 *Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof.*

Romans 6:13 *Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God.*

Romans 6:14 *For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.*

Romans 6:16 *Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?*

Romans 6:17 *But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you*

Romans 6:18 *Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness*

Romans 6:22 *But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.*

1 John 1:9 *If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.*

Ephesians 1:7 *In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;*

Hebrews 12:1 *Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us,*

Matthew 9:13 *But go ye and learn what that meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.*

Mark 3:28 *Verily I say unto you, All sins shall be forgiven unto the sons of men, and blasphemies wherewith soever they shall blaspheme:*

Acts 3:19 *Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord.*

Luke 5:20 *And when he saw their faith, he said unto him, Man, thy sins are forgiven thee*

Romans 5:8 *But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us*

Isaiah 1:18

Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool

Isaiah 44:22

I have blotted out, as a thick cloud, thy transgressions, and, as a cloud, thy sins: return unto me; for I have redeemed thee
